Prerequisites

1. Age requirements:

Bachelor degree program: 18-35 years old

Master degree program: 18-40 years old

Chinese language and TCM programs: 18-55 years old

2. Educational background:

Bachelor degree program: applicants must have attained Senior High School Diploma or above with decent grades

Master degree program: Bachelor's Degree with valid certificate

Chinese language program: Senior High School Diploma

TCM program: medical practitioner or medical student

3. Language requirements:

Bachelor degree program:

(1) Chinese language requirements- basic Chinese language ability;

(2) English language requirements- good English language ability. Applicants whose native language is not English must have academic IELTS 6.0 overall (no less than 5.0 in each item) or above, TOEFL online examination 70 points overall (no less than 15 points in each item) or above, or other equivalent English test results. Applicants whose native language is English or applicants whose instruction language during whole secondary school is English, the English test results can be exempted, but must submit the English performance result and English Teaching Certificate issued by the graduating secondary school.

Master degree program:

(1) Chinese language requirements- HSK 4 or above;

(2) English language requirements- skillful English language ability.

Chinese language program: good English language ability

TCM program: good English language ability

4. Applicants for Bachelor degree must pass SWMU Entrance Exam, the examination subjects are: English, mathematics, physics, chemistry and biology.

5. Applicants for Master degree programs must pass SWMU Interview.

6. Promise to buy medical insurance during study in our university.

7. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens in good physical and mental health condition.

Required Documents

1. SWMU Application Form for International Students (download in the website)

2. SWMU Student Family Information Form (download in the website)

3. Valid passport

4. Physical Examination Report, which must be original document with the seal of a government hospital

5. Financial Statement: Evidence of financial support

6. 10 ID photos, each in 2 inches with white background

**In addition to the above documents, different programs require different documents as following:*

Bachelor program:

Photocopies of Senior High School Diploma and Official Academic Records

Master program:

(1). Letter of No Criminal Record issued by local public security bureau

(2). Photocopies of Bachelor's Degree, Graduate Certificates and Official Academic Records and its notarization documents

- (3). Recommendation letters (minimum 2) and study plan
- (4). The certificate of HSK 4 or above

Chinese language and TCM program:

- (1). Letter of No Criminal Record issued by local public security bureau
- (2). Photocopies of highest degree and academic records obtained

Application Procedure

1. Time of Application:

Bachelor degree program: April 1st to June 30th each year

Master degree program: April 1st to July 30th each year

Chinese language and TCM programs: all year round

** Note: special cases can be admitted any time.*

2. The Confirmation Letter and Visa Application Form for International Students to China (form JW202) will be mailed to the qualified applicants, with which the students can apply for their “X” visas at the Chinese Embassy.
